PolyLife® (HDPE Solid Plastic) Care and Maintenance Instructions

One of the major benefits of PolyLife toilet partitions and lockers is the low maintenance and durability of the material used, HDPE. Just like any building material located in a high-traffic area, this solid plastic must be maintained in order to keep up its appearance. This guide will help you remove any dirt and graffiti, as well as buff out any cuts or scratches that may occur over time.

Dirt & Graffiti Removal

PolyLife material can be cleaned using a standard spray bottle or water hose, thanks to its moisture-proof surface.

For more stubborn messes we recommend:

- A pressure hose nozzle
- Using a cleaning solution made up of $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of household detergent, $\frac{2}{3}$ cup of trisodium phosphate, 1 gallon of water
- Non-abrasive industrial strength cleaner
- Remove glue or adhesives with acetone or mineral spirits (avoid hardware)

CAUTION: DO NOT USE ACID-BASED CLEANERS.

Buffing Cuts & Scratches

Polish away cuts and scratches by rubbing a smooth, round object (spoon, screwdriver handle, etc.) across the surface of the blemish. Use a heat gun or blow dryer to warm the surface of the material and make the removal of scratches easier.

TIP: Spray the surface of PolyLife material with silicone to give it a bright, like new appearance.
